# Frequently Asked Questions

## When do I need to apply for accommodation?

Applications for Accommodation are open from January onwards. Application forms are included with your "Offer Letter" or can be located on the website.

## How does the application process work?

When the accommodation department receive your application, they will email you to confirm safe receipt. You will then receive a Licence Agreement, which you need to complete and email back to the Accommodation Office.

You will also be required to put down a deposit of £250 - you will be sent the payment link to make this payment. If you have issues in making this payment, please contact the Accommodation Office to discuss.

On receipt of your deposit and Licence Agreement, the Accommodation Office will acknowledge receipt. Your room is then booked in readiness for your arrival in September.

## When will I know my room allocation details?

The Accommodation Office will contact you at the beginning of

September to confirm room allocation details.

## The University is not my first choice, when do I need to apply for accommodation?

You will need to apply for accommodation only when we become the University that you will be attending.

## I have now decided to study elsewhere; can I get my deposit monies back?

If you notify the Accommodation Office (by email) within 5 working days after A'Level results are confirmed, then your deposit will be refunded.

## Can I bring my car?

Parking is strictly limited on site with no guarantee of a space. We advise residential students not to bring their cars. However, if you would like to use the car park you will need to apply for a permit.

## Can I stay on Campus during the holidays?

Your license agreement covers the use of your room for 40 weeks, which includes the Christmas and Easter holidays.
