Contingency Regulations

- No plans to use contingency regulations put in place last year.
- Expectation that changes were made before students returned this year to adjust for covid-related changes.
- These should have been discussed with Collaborative Partnership Office

Changes to Regulations

- Non-submission no longer automatic fail for a module
- Creation of new module category for validation
 - Component Pass module
 - All components must be passed for module to be passed
- Withdrawal at exam boards

Withdrawal at Exam Boards

6.6.4.1 (1)

In all cases, where a student has failed module(s) which are not eligible for condonement, and the student has not made an effort to engage with the programme of study and/or has failed to attempt a majority of components in modules within the current Semester/Term, the Examining Board may decide that the student should not be permitted to be re-assessed and should be required to withdraw from the programme.

Criteria to be able to repeat a module

6.6.4.1 (10)

The following criteria must be considered before a student is allowed the opportunity to repeat a module or repeat a level:

- the student would be able to complete the award within the prescribed time limits;
- the student has made an effort to complete the requirements of the Programme of Study;
- the student's attendance record has generally been satisfactory;
- the student has engaged with the University's procedures for mitigating circumstances where appropriate;
- the student agrees to undertake any action considered necessary by the Programme Team to demonstrate his/her readiness to engage with the Programme of Study;
- there is a reasonable likelihood that the student would be successful;
- the student is not unfairly advantaged or disadvantaged.
