

Migrating from EndNote to RefWorks

• Product: New RefWorks

You can easily import your EndNote references into your RefWorks account:

- 1. In EndNote, go to Edit > Output Styles > Open Style Manager
- 2. Check RefMan (RIS) Export.
- 3. In your EndNote library, select the references you would like to export.
- 4. Go to File > Export and save the file, making sure the output styles field is set to RefMan (RIS) Export.
- 5. In RefWorks, click the "add"

6. Drag and drop the saved file or use the link to "select a file from your computer" and upload it.

7. RefWorks will try to auto-detect the type of file and find the correct import filter for it. You can also manually select the import filter.
