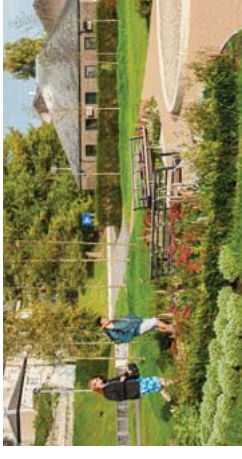

FAQ's



When do I need to apply for accommodation at UWTSd Lampeter Campus?

Applications for Accommodation are open from January. You can access the online application link on the accommodation website: www.uwtsd.ac.uk/accommodation

How does the application process work?

You will need your Student Number in order to register and make an application.

If you have any special requirements or requests then please add these to the "notes" section of the form.

If you have any issues, please contact the accommodation team; accommodation@uwtsd.ac.uk who will be able to assist you.

If you received a conditional offer of a place on your chosen programme, your place on the programme will be confirmed once Registry Admissions have received confirmation that you have met the terms of your offer. Your offer status for the programme will then become Unconditional Firm. If at this stage, you decide that you no longer require accommodation, log onto the Accommodation Booking portal and "Decline" the accommodation, this will then cancel your booking.

When will I know my room allocation details?

Applicants holding an unconditional firm place on their programme can expect to receive an e-mail from the Accommodation Office in September confirming details of their room allocation.

The University is not my first choice, when do I need to apply for accommodation?

You will need to apply for accommodation only when we become the University that you will be attending.

I have now decided to study elsewhere...

You will need to log onto the Accommodation Booking Portal to cancel your room.

Can I bring my car?

Parking is strictly limited on site with no guarantee of a space. We advise residential students not to bring their cars. However, if you would like to use the car park you will need to apply for a permit.

Can I stay on Campus during the holidays?

Your license agreement covers the use of your room for 38 weeks, which includes the Christmas and Easter holidays. If you need to extend your contract please contact the Accommodation Office to discuss.

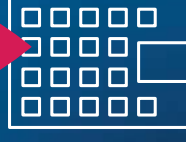

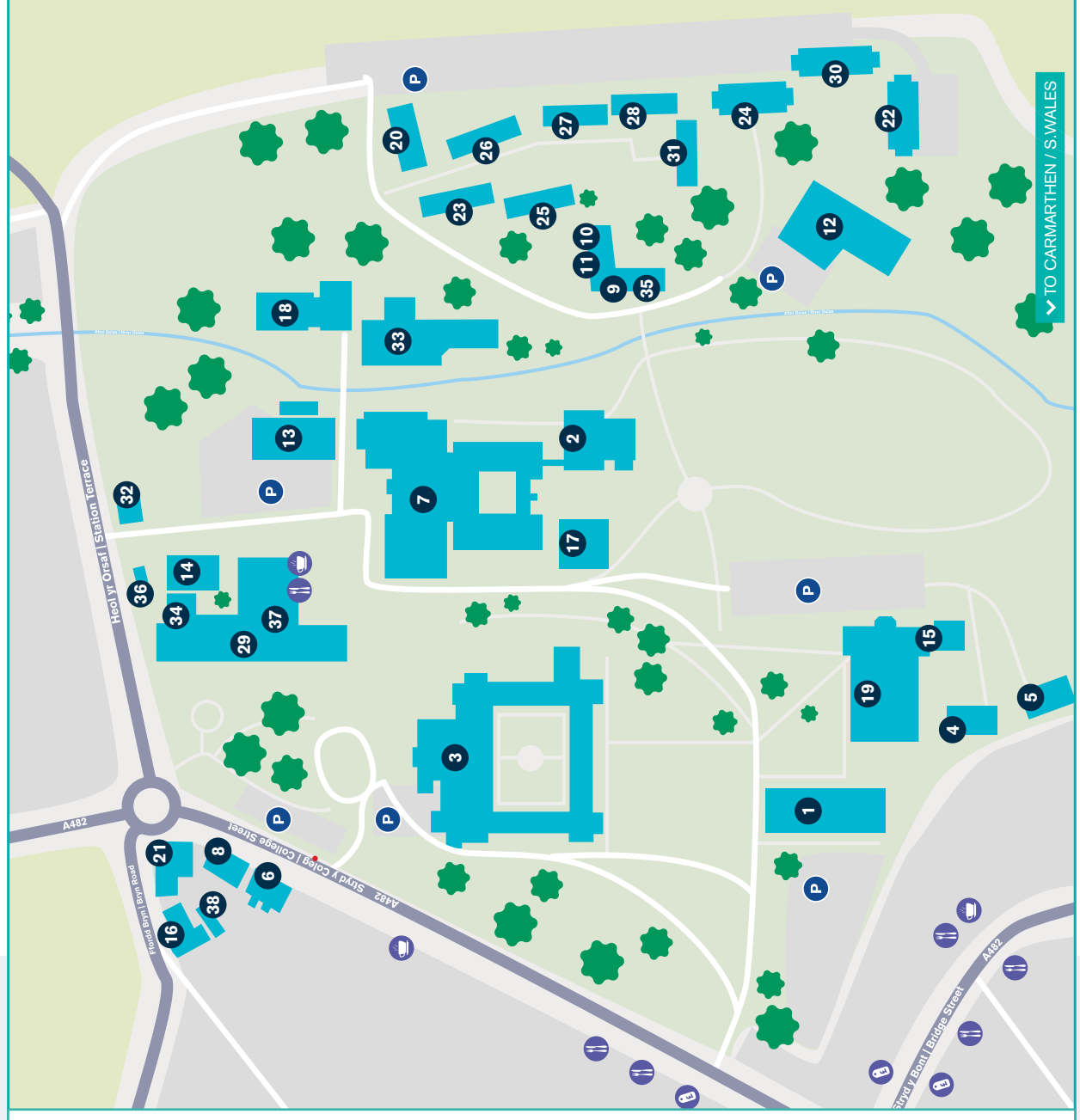

OUT AND ABOUT IN CEREDIGION

1 Cardigan Coast

Discover award winning sandy beaches with clear waters, caves, waterfalls, wild rugged cliffs and even a chance to see dolphins! There are numerous beaches of varying size along the Cardigan Bay coast including Llangrannog, New Quay and Poppit to name a few as well as many other hidden gems that can only be reached on foot using either local walks or the Wales coast path.

2 Welsh Heritage

Managed by the National Trust, The Lanerchaeron Estate near the coastal town of Aberaeron is a traditional welsh estate with a villa, servants' quarters, stables, farm buildings and walled garden. It is set in a landscape which is both beautiful and productive. Take a stroll around the picturesque gardens, visit the farm animals or enjoy light refreshments at the café.

3 Aberaeron

The first thing most people see when they approach Aberaeron are its unique, jewel-like, colourful houses. Whether you enjoy a stroll on the beach or some good pub grub, Aberaeron, on the Ceredigion coast, is a place where you can explore and unwind. Being the nearest seaside town to Lampeter, it boasts many independent shops, craft centres and outdoor dining facilities. Be sure to visit the Harbourmaster situated on the harbour for a cool, refreshing drink with a view.

WILD ABOUT NATURE?

New Quay is home to a large population of bottlenose dolphins that can often be seen leaping in the waters beyond the harbour wall. The daily boat trips will give you the chance to see these beautiful creatures as well as some other local wildlife in their natural habitat.
